

OCEANIA SHOOTING FEDERATION 2009 CONTINENTAL CHAMPIONSHIP



Competition Information

1. Dates and Venue

- 1.1 The Oceania Shooting Federation 2009 Continental Championship will be held in Sydney, Australia from 23rd November to 2nd December 2009.

2. Shooting Events as listed in the attached program

- 2.1 All Olympic I.S.S.F. Shotgun, Pistol & Rifle—Teams and Individual.
2.2 Disabled, Pistol & Rifle—Teams and Individual.
2.3 IMSUU both Individual and Teams

3. Participation

- 3.1 Grand Prix Event is open to all Individuals to enter.
3.2 Teams Event for A,B,C and Junior can only be entered by Oceania Countries
3.3 There will be no MQS available
3.4 The number of entries for team officials is not limited.
3.5 Please refer to attached registration forms for entry into this event.
3.6 Entries to all other events are as per the OSF rule book published June 2006.
3.7 If No Junior event occurs then can shoot as a Senior, this will not affect status in other Junior events.
3.8 The YOG match is different from the other Oceania matches. Shooters can shoot in other Junior or Senior matches.

4. Rules and Regulations

- 4.1 All competitions will be conducted under the current OSF Rules and Regulations.
4.2 Official Skeet Tape required to be used.
4.3 Sponsorship as outlined in the current rules will apply and be enforced.

5. Entry Process

- 5.1 Preliminary entries are to be sent to the Organising Committee by July 30th 2009.
5.2 The date for final entry will be October 15th 2009. 50% of the entry and accommodation fee will be due by the 15th of October. This information must include the names and ID numbers of all competitors. It should also include the names, dates of birth and official function of any officials.
5.3 Late entries as per ISSF/OSF Rules

6. The Ranges

- 6.1 The Sydney International Shooting Centre was built for the Sydney Olympic Games in 2000. It is situated to the west of Sydney, 50 km from the airport.
6.2 Light snacks, sandwiches, salads, fruit, drinks etc., will be available for competitors, officials and volunteers at the range.

7 Entry Visa

- 7.1 Federations that require entry visas to Australia are requested to contact their local Australian Consulate or Embassy.

8 Firearms

- 8.1 All competitors and team officials who may handle firearms must apply for a firearms licence. Junior competitors under the age of 18 years must also provide a copy of their current shooting permit and a letter from their parents supporting their application.
- 8.2 ***All air operated firearms, rifle and pistols including pellets, must also have an import licence and must be declared***
- 8.3 All firearms must be secured at the official armoury upon arrival.
- 8.4 All Firearm & Ammunition forms must be returned to the Organising Committee by no later than September 30th 2009 and must be accompanied by the appropriate fee of \$85.00 per person. Bank details are as per cl.25.2 Or if you are arranging your own firearms form please make contact with NSW firearms Registration on permits@police.nsw.gov.au

9. Customs formalities

- 9.1 The firearm permit allows the firearm to come into Australia; however the Australian Customs service also needs to confirm all firearms imported are taken out of the country. The customs departure form will be posted on the AISL website www.ausshooting.org/oceania and available at registration. Assistance in completing these will be available on the range. (there is no charge)

10. Assistance upon arrival

- 10.1 Please advise should you need assistance on arrival.

11. Accommodation

- 11.1 A list of hotels recommended by Australian International Shooting Ltd (AISL) is shown as Appendix A, please contact them direct to arrange your accommodation.

12 Information on Range Equipment

- 12.1 The SISC Range is equipped with equipment conforming to the ISSF Rules:
- 50m range ----- 60 firing points (SIUS ASCOR)
 - 10m range ----- 60 firing points (SIUS ASCOR)
 - 25m range ----- 10 groups of targets (SIUS ASCOR)
 - Finals range ----- 10 groups of targets (SIUS ASCOR)
- 12.2 The Shotgun ranges comprise the Olympic Trap and Skeet layouts equipped with Matarelli machines.
- 12.3 IMSUU range is the Sporting Shooters Madura Range.

13 Ammunition & Arms Storage

- 13.1 Competitors may bring ammunition with them but should consider the limit which is permitted by the airlines.

- 13.2 A limited range of ammunition will be available for purchase on the range; if you have a preference please advise and we can generally place on order.
- 13.3 The firearms and ammunition brought by each participating team will be deposited at the shooting range armoury.

14 Fees

- 14.1 *Entry fees all Events* AUD \$150 per shooter /event
- 14.2 *Official's fee:* AUD \$100 per official
- 14.3 *Team Entry fee:* included
- 14.4 *Shotgun Training Fees:* AUD\$7.00 per round Trap and Skeet and AUD\$14.00 for Double Trap
- 14.5 *Firearms Permit:* AUD\$85 per permit (AUS. Firearms Regulation)
- 14.6 *Official training for Championship* No charge – 1 round only
- 14.7 *Unofficial Training* If available and within the rules ranges may be available for use at the fee set by the range management.
- 14.8 *Airport Tax* Passengers of international airlines are reminded, where applicable, to pay the airport tax on departure at the Sydney International Airport.

15 Registration and method of payment

- 15.1 50% Deposit of entry fees needs to be paid to organising committee by 15th October 2009.
- 15.2 All participating teams must complete the registration for the final entry confirmation as well as the balance of any payment for the entry fees to the Organizing Committee either by bank transfer prior to arrival or at the shooting range by 1000 hours on November 28th, 2009.
- 15.3 All cash payments may be made in Australian Dollars.
- 15.4 Bank details for early transfer of funds are listed under item 25 "Contacts".

16. Local Transport

- 16.1 There will be no official transport. A list of car companies that AISL recommends is shown on Appendix B for you to hire.

17. ISSF Identification (ID) No.

- 17.1 Where applicable all ISSF entries must have an ISSF Number at the time of registration.

18 Doping Control

- 18.1 All doping control will be conducted in accordance with the relevant IF Anti Doping Regulations by the Australia Sports Anti-Doping Agency, which is accredited with the WADA.
- 18.2 Athletes and coaches are reminded that the IF must be advised in writing, and BEFORE the competition, of any medications taken by competitors, and that a copy of TUE must also be provided to the Organising Committee.

19 Ceremonies / Meetings

- 19.1 Technical Meeting will take place at 8.00am on the 28th of November on the Finals range at SISC
- 19.2 Executive Meeting will take place on the 28th November at 11am.
- 19.3 General Meeting will take place on the 30th November at 11am.

- 19.4 Award Ceremonies will be conducted following the match or where finals are held after the Finals. Enough time will be allowed following each match for the winners to change into Official National Uniform or Official National Tracksuit.

The Award Ceremony for the Grand Prix events will be conducted at the conclusion of the match following protest time.

- 19.5 Flags: All participating teams are required to bring with them two of their national flags (Minimum size: 1 m X 1.5m approx.), and one national anthem on standard cassette tape (40-50 seconds) or CD for the Opening Ceremony and Victory Ceremony.

20. Climate

- 20.1 The mean daily maximum temperature in November - December in Sydney is between around 25C and the mean daily minimum is 14 C. The average rainfall is 78mm for the month. Sunshine hours are 8 and days of sunshine are 20. (Generally this adds up to good weather)

21 Media Relations

- 21.1 Limited on-site press facilities will be available and further details may be obtained via the organising committees email events@ausshooting.org Press Conference facilities will be available.

22. Industry/Exhibitions

- 22.1 It is planned that a gunsmith will be on site at the Sydney International Shooting Centre.
22.2 Companies wishing to sell or exhibit their product are asked to contact the organisers by September 15.

23. Classification

- 23.1 Classification will be available everyday from the 27th November until the end of the Competition.

- 24.1 Team Event medals will be the Continental Championships medal
24.2 Individual entry medals will be the Oceania
